

Cyclists don't miss The Bike Ballot. It's your opportunity to share your thoughts and suggestions with Asheville's progressive incumbents, Bryan Freeborn and Brownie Newman, Nov 3rd from 4-6pm at Asheville Pizza and Brewing on Coxe Ave.

After Saturday's ride enjoy a slice, a beer and review Asheville's Bicycle Network Map with the council members who have supported it throughout its development (http://www.fbrmpo.org/Bicycle_and_Pedestrian.html).

Freeborn and Brownie are up for re-election and need the bike vote in order to continue moving Asheville towards multimodal transportation.

Vote early and often. Take advantage of early voting at the Buncombe County Board of Election located at 189 College Street downtown. Check out the hours and days below. Early voting polls are open:

Oct. 22nd – Nov. 2nd from 8am – 6pm

Nov 3rd from 8am – 1pm.

Vote and register the same day. One-stop voting is an option, as well. Simply bring one of the following to the Board of Election. You only need:

- 1) NC driver's license
- 2) utility bill
- 3) bank statement
- 4) payroll check
- 5) document from a government agency.

Should you need more information call the Board of Election at (828) 250-4200. When you vote, vote as a cyclist. See you at the Bike Ballot.
